HOW DOES IT WORK?

The very first step is for you to register your interest by filling out the registration form <u>here</u>.

Once you've signed up for Flowers for Florists, you will be on our dedicated wholesale mailing list.

Every Friday from April to October our weekly newsletter will then land in your inbox with lots of our field-grown flowers to tempt you in.

Join Rachel for a virtual Field Walk to see what's looking at its best in the fields and tunnels and pick up tips on how the material behaves in the vase.

And, of course, you will find the all-important link to the Picking List where you will be able to order everything you need for the week ahead.



AVAILABILITY

The range available for you to pick from each week will gradually increase as the days lengthen, reaching its peak by midsummer. There will be new treasures to discover every couple of weeks as the seasons unfurl.

Take a look at our Flower Calendar at the end of this brochure to get an idea of what will be in flower each month. The weather will inevitably have a hand to play in what is available and when.







PICKING LISTS

Every Friday between April and October, you will receive the Picking List as a downloadable spreadsheet in our weekly Flowers for Florists newsletter.

The Picking List will detail all the available varieties together with the price per bunch of 10 stems.

Our flowers are subject to availability on a first come first served basis, so we strongly recommend ordering as soon as possible to avoid disappointment.





ORDERING ESSENTIALS

We operate a £100 minimum order for wholesale sales.

All varieties are sold in bunches of ten stems.

Stems are cut to order and fully conditioned.

We request that orders are placed 48 hours prior to collection.

PRE-ORDERS

We do not yet offer a pre-order service for florists, but plan to open pre-ordering from Spring 2025.

FLOWERS FOR FLORISTS COLLECTION


Flowers for Florists is a collection only service.

We ask you to specify the date and time you wish to collect at the time of placing your order, so that we can have your flowers ready and in perfect condition.

You are welcome to choose to collect your flower order on either Wednesday, Thursday or Friday between the hours of 9am and 4pm.

April

Anemones, Hazel, Hellebores, Icelandic Poppies, Narcissi, Ranunculus, Spiraea

May

Alliums, Buttercups, Geums, Foxgloves, Hornbeam, Irises, Icelandic Poppies, Linaria, Orlaya, Peonies, Ranunculus, Sweet Peas, Sweet Rocket, Viburnum, Weigela







WHAT'S IN SEASON?

June

Astrantia, Calendula, Campanula, Clematis, Corncockle, Cornflowers, Daucus, Delphiniums, Mint, Nigella, Peonies, Physocarpos, Roses, Silene, Sweet Peas, Sweet Williams

July

Achillea, Antirrhinums, Dahlias, Eryngium, Foxgloves, Mint, Nicotiana, Nigella, Phlox, Roses, Scabious, Sunflowers, Zinnias



WHAT'S IN SEASON?

August

Antirrhinums, Dahlias, Grasses, Helichrysum, Hydrangea, Hypericum, Molucella, Rudbeckia, Sanguisorba

September

Acidanthera, Abelia, Chrysanthemums, Cosmos, Delphiniums, Dahlias, Grasses, Roses, Scented Pelargonium, Snowberry, Zinnia

October

Asters, Chrysanthemums, Dahlias, Grasses
